

TGT / PGT Exam Details

Various states secondary education service selection board conduct TGT/ PGT Recruitment Examination. UPSESSB, DSESSB etc. is responsible for organizing this state-level teacher recruitment exam to appoint Trained Graduate Teachers (TGT) and Lecturer (PGT) in various state non official inter colleges and schools. The board issues an official notification to invite all the interested male and female candidates to apply for the posts of Trained Graduate Teacher and Post Graduate Teacher (Lecturer). This is a great opportunity for all the candidates who wish to have a career in the teaching field. The candidates can apply by filling an online application form.

Age limit: Age should not be less than 21 years (There is relaxation in age limit rules as per government norms).

Nationality: A candidate for direct recruitment to the post of a teacher must be

- a citizen of India; or
- a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before the 1st day of January, 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India; or
- a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka or any of the East African countries of Kenya, Uganda and the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar) with the intention of permanently settling in India.

Educational Qualification:

- **For PGT:** Candidates must have a Post-Graduation Degree in a relevant subject.
- **For TGT:** Candidates must possess a Graduation Degree in a relevant subject and B.Ed/BTC or any other training certificate.

In addition to this, the educational qualification for the candidate varies for every subject. So, in order to throw some a light on that, let us discuss the subjects and the related qualification that is required.

UP TGT/ PGT Selection Process

The Selection Process for the post of Lecturer and Trained Graduate Teacher is completed in 3 stages.

1. **Written Examination:** It is a state level exam which consists of one question paper for TGT and one for PGT. Questions will be related to the subject that you have selected in the application form. The questions will be objective type i.e multiple choice questions.
2. Special Qualification
3. Personal Interview Test

UP TGT PGT 2016 Exam Pattern: UP TGT PGT Exam Pattern is as Follows:

1. There will be One Question Paper in the Exam.
2. Written Exam has Objective Multiple Choice Type Questions.
3. Time Duration for Written Exam is 120 Minutes (02 Hours).
4. Questions will be from related Subjects of Trained Graduate Teacher Level OR Post Graduate Teacher Level.

The total marks for the examination are divided in the following manner

- 85% in the Written Examination (both for TGT and PGT).
- 10% in the Personal Interview.
- 5% for Special Qualification (PHd/ M.Phil- 2%, M.Ed-2%, B.Ed-1%).
